This Union Notes:

1. UBU Sports and societies are an integral part of the life of many students at Bradford University
2. Sports clubs mainly have matches and/or training sessions on Wednesday afternoons.
3. Societies often have meetings or exec meetings on Wednesday afternoons.
4. University Departments are increasingly using Wednesday afternoons for lectures, practicals and seminars.
5. Wednesday afternoons are also used for other students activities, group meetings and more.
6. The University has previously approved the policy regarding the use of Wednesday afternoons for extra-curricular student activities.

This Union Believes

1. Wednesday afternoons from 12 noon should be kept completely free from lectures, practicals and seminars.

This Union Resolves

1. To campaign for Wednesday afternoons from 12 to remain free for extra-curricular student activities.
2. To direct both the Academic Affairs Officer and the Sports And Societies Officer through their roles to ensure that this action is taken.
3. For the Executive Committee to promote the view that a decrease in extra curricular activities will affect recruitment, therefore Wednesday afternoon lectures etc would be counter-productive.
