This Union notes

1. The University and the UBU hold many events and have many areas that involve music, in particular, loud music
2. Students – like the population at large – can have their hearing affected by loud music and / or sounds, and, even more so, through excessive use of .mp3 players at a loud volume

This Union believes

1. Students should be able to minimise the risk of hearing damage
2. Students should be aware of the dangers of loud music
3. Basement / Colours / Escape events should monitor sound levels

This Union resolves

1. The union should support the RNID's 'Don't Lose The Music' campaign at www.dontlosethemusic.com
2. The union should work closely with RamAir, bars and events and the Bradford Student to promote safety with loud music and through use of .mp3 players
3. Ear plugs should be provided for students and their availability publicised around the communal building
4. The sabbatical officer responsible for implementing this is the communications officer – with correspondence between the entertainment, bar and RamAir managers – and should report back to council by the end of the 2007/08 academic year.
5. This motion should be reviewed in one year's time by council.
